### News from Series Director F. Allen Shirley:

#### Series Update:

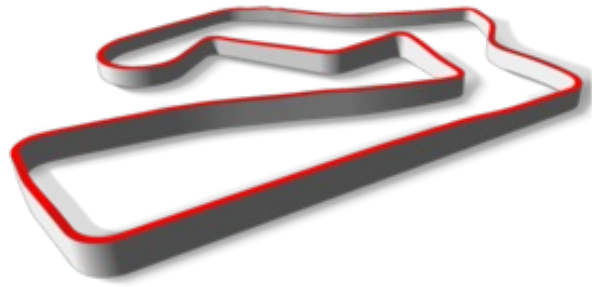
We're just inside of three weeks before Road America Round 5 so it's time to let you know what has transpired behind the scenes since Round 4 at VIR.

1. Since we began the series at Road Atlanta back in April, there have been continuous conversations about the damper/spring configuration. At our driver/team meeting at VIR, the consensus was that we would continue to search for a solution to the configuration and if found, would institute the change for the 2017 season. We have been working in concert with PMNA to provide a new combination of dampers and springs that will be acceptable to the majority of series players. Since we began the search to find an acceptable solution, KW has developed and tested a package that they refer to as the Trophy Nurburgring which they have provided to teams in Europe as an alternative to how the GT4CS was originally delivered. PMNA has also tested the package at two races in Canada (Mosport and Toronto) over the last month with positive results. PMNA is working with KW to determine exactly when they will have the package available for the Trophy East series.
2. We have also been working with PMNA to allow teams to use steering wheels other than those already provided in the cars. There is not currently a quick release wheel offered by Porsche. As you are aware, the electronics of the car are very sensitive and the addition of any item that requires interfacing that has not been tested by Porsche can cause problems. Although not endorsed by Porsche, there is a manufacturer of an aftermarket PDK/Quick Release steering wheel made specifically for the 981/991. The company is KMP ([www.k-m-p.nl](http://www.k-m-p.nl)) located in Holland. If you are interested in using this steering wheel, please contact KMP for more information.
3. Daytonais shaping up to be an outstanding end-of-the-year event. The heart of America endurance racing offers the perfect venue to run our season finale. When it's all over on Sunday, we'll have a year-end banquet to celebrate your 2016 season with awards, prizes and a special speaker in the Goodyear 500 Club.
